

Contract terms

Payment Terms

Paypal, Credit Card (Through Paypal), Check, and Money Order are all acceptable forms of payment.

For projects estimated under \$100

Paypal, Credit Card – Work will be started immediately; final payment is expected before final delivery.

Check, Money Order – Work will not be started until payment has been received in full, and check has cleared. Post dated checks are accepted, however proofs will not be given until after check has cleared to ensure full payment.

For projects estimated over \$100

Paypal, Credit Card – Work will be started when set upon deposit amount is received, typically 25-50%. Depending on project, payment schedule will be set up, and final payment is expected before final delivery.

Check, Money Order – Work will be started when set upon deposit amount is received, and cleared, typically 25-50%. Depending on project, payment schedule will be set up, and final payment is expected before final delivery. Post dated checks are accepted, however, phases and their related proofs will move forward only after check has cleared to ensure full payment

Deposits are non refundable.

Additional Fees

In the course of design there are occasionally instances that come up where the original estimate needs to be changed. The following are a few of the most common instances.

Alterations

Every design instance comes with 3 watermarked proofs for the customer to approve, and make alterations (Two mid and one final). After these two standard alterations, all following instances are \$15 each, to be added onto the final payment.

Cancellation

In the occasion where it is decided to no longer move forward with a project, the artist reserves all exclusive rights to the work that has been produced up to this point, in addition to a cancellation fee for breach of contract as follows.

The fee will be in direct relation as 75% of the cost of the work done on the project to date. ie: if a project estimated at \$200, is stopped halfway through, the fee would be \$75. If said project was cancelled after completion, the fee would be \$150.
